
Our Moreton Bay


We respect and learn from the Jinibara, Kabi Kabi and Turrbal Traditional Custodians, past, present and emerging.

Our city's snapshot




Our vision

In July 2023, we transformed from a regional centre to Australia's newest city. Now, as City of Moreton Bay, we're re-writing the rule book on what a modern city can be.


Our polycentric city model moves away from the traditional city model, where jobs and infrastructure are concentrated in a single place, like a CBD. Our deliberate multi-centre approach means we have more than one urban centre.

The result? By creating stronger ties between our existing centres of Caboolture, Morayfield, North Lakes, Redcliffe, Petrie and Strathpine, we're paving the way for incredible economic growth, improved social outcomes, and better protection for our natural environment.



Our future city vision means:

- A fairer city for everyone, where housing, employment and lifestyle opportunities are shared across the area
- Reduced road traffic, as residents aren't funnelled into a single CBD to work
- Less time wasted commuting every day means more time for family recreation
- This keeps money in our city with increased resident spending and income
- Reduced commutes also mean less greenhouse gas emitted
- Greater funding and investment opportunities, creating new infrastructure, transport, sports and recreation facilities, new suburbs and business hubs, sources of economic growth, and so much more
- We can preserve and invest in the lifestyle and distinct communities we love now, so we don't lose our character in the face of incredible population growth






Our roadmap
