MEMORIALS OR CONDOLENCES 3.

Cr Peter Flannery reported he had attended the service of the late Mrs Delma Rankin who passed away recently aged 81. Cr Flannery said that he first met Delma in 2004 when she would bring cakes to Council and tell stories of her husband who served in the services. Mrs Rankin is remembered as a very independent woman having maintained seven acres of land by herself for many years.

Cr Peter Flannery also made special mention of the late Mr Tom McLoughlin who passed away recently aged 90. Mr McLoughlin had served in the position of Mayor and as a Councillor of the former Caboolture Shire Council, over a 30-year period from 1970 to 2000. Mr McLoughlin served as Deputy Shire Chairman for six years, Finance Committee Chairman for nine years, and was Mayor from 1997 to 2000. He commenced in Queensland Railways, purchased a farm in Morayfield where he grew poultry and pineapples and was Development Manager at Morayfield Shopping Centre. Cr Flannery said that Mr McLoughlin was passionate about politics and water issues in the region - having recorded all rain events, and left behind a great legacy.

Cr Adrian Raedel concurred with Cr Flannery's comments adding that he first met Mr McLoughlin in the 2001 bi-election. Cr Raedel added that he was also passionate about the Caboolture Historical Village and the Showgrounds and that he and his wife Pat attended all of the Annual General Meetings and will be sorely missed by his colleagues.

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3. Memorials or Condolences (cont'd)

Cr Adrian Raedel also made mention of the late **Mrs Joyce Newton of Maleny** who passed away recently, and although not a resident, had contributed to the political landscape of the Moreton Bay Region. Cr Raedel said that Mrs Newton was heavily involved in politics and was passionate about the region and will be missed by her community.

7.1. Community Comment - Aleasha Bliss - Fort Bribie and its demise (A17746232)

As part of the Community Comment session, Aleasha Bliss addressed the Council in respect of Fort Bribie and its demise, making the following points:

- Visitors to Fort Bribie find the forts crumbling, disrespected with litter and graffiti, and this poses safety and structural issues.
- In 2016, the State government committed \$48,797 to the maintenance of the forts, however there appears to have been no cleaning, maintenance or restoration of the forts.

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7.1. Community Comment - Aleasha Bliss - Fort Bribie and its demise (cont'd)

- The Department advise a spending of \$75,000 during the last 12 months at the site by maintaining fencing, signage, barriers and grilles, but not the fort structure. The wire fencing and signage at the site does not protect the structures or prevent trespassing.
- Other WWII forts, structures and relics have been maintained throughout Australia and the Queensland coast, while Fort Bribie is left to rot.
- Does Council have a plan to conserve the Fort Bribie structures or a plan to increase their maintenance?

The Mayor thanked Aleasha Bliss for her participation in Community Comment advising that the matter will be referred to the relevant department.
