Community Facilities Interest Free Loan Program Guidelines

Introduction

This program provides interest free loans to community organisations to develop new or improve existing community facilities in the City of Moreton Bay. Projects funded by an interest free loan will plan and deliver community facilities where people can participate in community, cultural, sporting and environmental activities in the City of Moreton Bay.

The Community Facilities Interest Free Loan Program and these guidelines are governed by the City of Moreton Bay Community Interest Free Loans Policy (No. 2150-098).

Applications can be submitted at any time. Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their application within approximately six weeks from the date of Council receiving a complete application.

Successful projects must not commence prior to receiving written notification from Council.

Who Can Apply?

Eligible applicants	 A community organisation that applies for funding under this grant must meet the following criteria: Be based in the City of Moreton Bay and/or can demonstrate that the proposed project relates to a community facility in the City of Moreton Bay; Have \$20 million public liability insurance; Have acquitted all previous City of Moreton Bay grants; Have no outstanding debts to Council; Demonstrate the financial capacity to repay the loan amount within the agreed timeframe; and Either: Have an existing land tenure agreement with Council; or Have an existing land tenure agreement with a lessee of Council; or Be the owner/trustee of the land and/or the community facility. Definitions Community organisation means: a) an entity that carries on activities for a public purpose; or b) another entity whose primary object is not directed at making a profit.
Ineligible applicants	The following are ineligible organisation types: • For-profit entities; • Government departments and agencies; • Schools and affiliated parents' associations; • Kindergartens and childcare organisations; • Churches; • Political groups; • Individuals; and

Supporting documents	 Current public liability insurance certificate; Most recent audited or verified financial statements for the past two years; Landowner's consent; Approval documents (e.g. development approval, construction drawings); Site maps / plans; and Quotes.
Assessment criteria	 Eligible applications will be assessed against the following criteria: Need The application identifies a need (community or organisational). The project addresses this need. Benefit The project demonstrates a benefit for City of Moreton Bay residents. Value for money The budget is realistic and expenditure items are relevant to the project. The project uses local suppliers where possible. Capacity to deliver the project The organisation has the skills and resources (internal or external) to deliver the project. The project plan demonstrates an understanding of the project stages.
Loan agreement and repayments	 Successful applicants are required to enter into an agreement with Council that outlines the terms and conditions of the loan, as well as an agreed loan repayment schedule. Successful projects must not commence prior to receiving written notification from Council. All interest free loans must be repaid to Council within a period not exceeding 10 years.
Unsuccessful applicants	Unsuccessful applicants may seek feedback on their application by contacting a Grants Officer (see contact details below).
