- **Register** your school / centre online **by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2024 at 5pm**. You will then receive a Teacher Information Booklet and be required to complete a Champion Site Profile form online.
- Collect and enter data regarding the waste services, volumes, and practices at your school / centre. Complete online the Champion Site Report by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024 at 5pm.
- Plan, implement, and refine your waste management practices and behaviours.
- **Complete online** your final Champion Site Report that demonstrates improvements in your waste management practices by **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2024 at 5pm**.

Final Champion Site Reports will be evaluated against a set of criteria including efforts in waste avoidance, reduction, reuse, and recycling. All submissions will receive a report card providing feedback and suggestions for improving best practices in waste management.

Submissions that meet the criteria of a 'Sustainability Champion' will be contacted by Council's waste minimisation team for a site visit and inspection. Sites that are awarded 'Sustainability Champion' status will be provided with a certificate and an award to be publicly displayed at the school / centre.
