Registration fee concessions

Desexed - concession applies when a Certificate of sterilisation/desexing has been provided to Council.

Pensioner - concession applies to holders of a current blue Centrelink pension card, DVA Blue pension card or a DVA gold repatriation health card when a copy of the current pension concession card has been provided to Council.

Recognised Animal Association - concession applies when evidence of a current membership has been provided from Dogs QLD, Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC), Cats QLD Inc, Feline Control Council of QLD Inc or QLD Feline Association Inc. The evidence is required to be provided annually.

Registration and fee exemptions

Exemption from Registration applies to:

Government entity dogs - As defined in the *Animal Management (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008*, these dogs are owned by a government entity or a person engaged or employed by the entity; and must be used for a purpose under an Act of the Commonwealth or a State e.g.

- · Corrective services dog
- · Explosives detection dog
- · Drug detection dog
- Defence forces/Police dog

Supporting documentation from the government entity must be submitted to Council.

Working dogs - Dogs kept on rural zoned land and used (or being trained) primarily for the purpose of droving, protecting, tending or working stock, as defined in the *Animal Management* (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008.

To be exempt the following must be supplied:

- completed 'Working dog self-assessment checklist' (available by contacting Council)
- ABN of primary business

Canine plasma dog - Dogs that are kept for the production of canine plasma products derived completely or partly from the plasma of the dog. The dog owner is required to provide proof of registration under the *Animal Care and Protection Act 2001* to use the dog for that purpose.

Registration fee exemptions applies to:

Exemptions from cat and dog registration fees apply to:

- Assistance Dogs if they comply with the Guide, Hearing and Assistance Dogs Act 2009 or the Disability Discrimination Act 1992.
- Foster Animals registered in the name of a recognised foster organisation.

Registration renewals

The annual registration period for dogs and cats is 1 October to 30 September each year. Animal registration renewals are issued in September each year.

Animal Classification

Dangerous dog / Menacing dog - Animal has been declared a dangerous or menacing dog by a local government authority.

Restricted Breeds - PROHIBITED

Restricted breed - The following breeds are defined as Restricted dogs under the *Customs Act 1901 (Cwlth):*

- Dogo Argentino
- Presa Canario
- American Pit Bull

- Fila Brasileiro
- Japanese Tosa
- Pit Bull Terrier

Change of animal registration details

The following animal registration details can be submitted online

- Change of address
- Change of contact phone numbers
- Supply evidence of concession or desexing
- Advise council that your cat or dog has moved out of the region or is deceased.

If your animal has recently been microchipped contact council to update your animal registration details and ensure you provide your pet's details to a microchip registry.

Cat and dog identification tags

Council's *Animal Management Local Law 2023* specifies cats and dogs must wear an identification tag when at a place other than the address stated in the registration notice.

There is a requirement for cats and dogs to wear an identification tag which contains the current telephone number of the owner of the animal.

Responsible pet ownership

As a responsible pet owner, you have an obligation to ensure your pet does not cause a nuisance to other people or the environment.

- Take all reasonable steps to prevent your animal from making a noise or nuisance
- Suitable fencing and/or enclosures are required to prevent cats and dogs from wandering from their property.
- Keep cats and dogs in a public place on a leash, unless in a designated off-leash area.
- Be prepared by carrying plastic bags or a pooper scooper to pick up after your animal.
- The number of cats and dogs that you can have is dependent on the size of your property.

Microchipping of cats and dogs

Queensland legislation requires that all dogs and cats born after April 2009 must be microchipped. All dogs and cats must be microchipped at point of sale or transfer to a new owner.

Properties where dogs are not permitted

In order to minimise impacts upon koala habitat, dogs are prohibited from being kept at particular properties in Desmond Street, Narangba, Samuel Way, Narangba or Steven Court, Narangba. Contact council for further information. Persons must not keep dogs or cats in a caravan park or camping ground.
