

As part of the upgrade of Old Gympie Road between Boundary Road, Dakabin and Anzac Avenue, Kallangur, work to relocate overhead and underground services will soon commence between Hight Street to Viney Avenue.

What specific works are being done?

This work includes:

- installing underground power conduits
- installing new service pillars and underground power connection from the pillar to the meter box inside some properties (pillars are the green cases that contain where live electrical wires terminate that connect a house to the power network)
- connecting streetlights to the new underground power network
- relocating power poles.

See over the page for a map indicating the location of the works. If your property will be affected by the work, you have already been contacted by Council officers and have written agreements in place.

When will the work be done?

The work will commence in October 2024 and is expected to conclude by March 2025, pending weather and other unforeseeable circumstance. Works will take place during the day, between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday.

How will you be affected?

There will be no road closures during the work however there may be some traffic control measures in place to ensure workers' safety. There will also be some noise impacts from construction works. Council representatives will liaise directly with individual property owners before carrying out works on their properties.
